

Windows and Sliding Glass Door Maintenance and Cleaning

Your new TRACO windows and doors will last for many years with a minimum of maintenance and routine care when these guidelines are followed:

Glass Cleaning – The window glass can be cleaned with any standard non-abrasive glass cleaner.

Lubricate the moving parts with Silicone Spray (Black Magic Silicone can be found in any auto parts store).

Windows

Every Month: Operate sash several times to keep the balances lubricated and prevents sticking. Inspect for broken or missing hardware and weather stripping.

Every Three Months: Vacuum the window frame sill to remove debris, dirt or foreign matter which may have accumulated.

Every Six Months: Clean the window frame, sill, and jambs with a mild soap solution to remove any buildup of dirt, sludge, or grime, which may interfere with the operation.

Sliding Glass Doors

Every Three Months: Vacuum the door frame sill to remove debris, dirt or foreign matter which may have accumulated. Inspect for broken or missing parts and weather stripping.

Every Six Months: Clean the door frame, sill, and jambs with a mild soap solution to remove any buildup of dirt, sludge, or grime, which may interfere with the roller system.
