RECYCLING GUIDELINES



Steel & Aluminum Containers and Foil



Cardboard (flattened),
Office Paper, Newspaper, Magazines



Clean & Empty

Replace lids & caps

Put material in loose - Not in Bags



Containers: Bottles & Jars Only

PLASTIC

Containers: Bottles, Tubs, Jugs, and Jars Only



CARTONS



No Plastic Bags No Product Wrap (return clean to retailer)



No Tanglers (Hangers, Hoses, Wire, Cords, Ropes or Chains)



No Big Items (Electronics, Wood, Propane Tanks, Scrap Metal or Styrofoam – check with local authority for other options)



No Clothing Textiles or Shoes (donate)



No Food, Liquid, Diapers, Batteries or Needles





These Guidelines represent the common items accepted in most recycling programs.

SINGLE SOURCE:

- Rinse your glass, plastics, and cartons.
- Please DO NOT throw recyclables down the chute(s).
- Break down all cardboard boxes.
- Recyclables do not need to be separated by type.
- Place all recyclables in the following locations for both James House and Kilmer House:
 JAMES HOUSE: Basement nearest the freight elevators, rear of the building outside
 Receiving, and near mailboxes for junk mail, etc.

KILMER HOUSE: Garage next to the office across from electronic recycling, and near mailboxes for junk mail, etc.

Please refer to the map for specific locations.

ACCEPTED ITEMS - office paper, newspaper, magazines and junk mail, flattened cardboard, glass bottles and jars (only), plastic bottles, tubs, jugs and jars (only), plastic #1-7, aluminum containers and foil, tin & steel.

NON-ACCEPTED ITEMS - product wrap or plastic bags, scrap metal or styrofoam, clothing or shoes, food, liquid, diapers, batteries or needles.

Everyone is encouraged to participate in recycling to benefit you and your environment.

ELECTRONIC:

Electronic Recycling for both James House and Kilmer House is located outside the Garage office.

ACCEPTED ELECTRONIC ITEMS - cables and cords; cable boxes; cash registers; cell phones; computer servers and laptops, parts, monitors and peripherals; printers and copiers; DVD players; fax and scanners; MP3/iPod players; projectors; TV's and VCRs; satellite dishes; stereos; typewriters; UPS units (Uninterrupted Power Supplies); and video game consoles.

ACCEPTED HOUSEHOLD ITEMS - blenders (without glass); bread makers; carpet sweepers (corded or rechargeable); coffee makers (without glass); clocks; curling irons; electric knives; electric toothbrushes; fans; food sealing equipment; fryers; hair cutters; hair dryers; heaters; holiday lights; irons; landline phones; massagers; metal tools (drills, screwdrivers, small saws, sanders, etc.); mixers; remotes; radios; shaving equipment; toaster ovens; vacuum cleaner (without bag).

NON-ACCEPTED ITEMS - air conditioners and freon containing items; microwaves; ballasts and light bulbs; capacitors; dehumidifiers; gas cylinders; liquids or items containing liquids; household batteries (AA, AAA, C, D); lithium batteries; medical equipment* (any material that is considered or has come in contact with biohazard or radioactive material); VHS cassette tapes; white goods (refrigerators, dish washers, stoves, washers/dryers).

BATTERIES:

There is one location for batteries: A blue bucket is on the wall in the James House basement nearest the freight elevators to recycle your batteries (AA, AAA, C, D). All batteries must be taped individually or placed individually in plastic bags.

Please refer to the map for (B) specific location.

Everyone is encouraged to participate in recycling to benefit you and your environment.
